

ACTIVATING ADELAIDE: PILOT PROJECTS

'Pilot Projects' is an opportunity to quickly activate selected locations around the city by trying out new business opportunities and new city improvements. The projects are intended to allow both businesses and the public to experience new concepts before committing to them in the long term.

The chosen projects will:

- not require application or licence fees.
- not involve any permanent capital works

Business owners, community groups and residents are encouraged to submit their ideas to Adelaide City Council.

The pilot program will run from October 2011 to March 2012.

Who can apply?

Business owners can submit proposals for using public areas to test new business ideas.

Community groups and residents are encouraged to submit ideas to Council about what they think we could do to make the city more active, interesting and fun.

Examples of Test Projects

Ideas for businesses might be to:

- establish or extend their outdoor dining areas or footpath lounges
- create murals on building walls
- park food carts in various locations around the city

Ideas community groups and residents could propose might include:

- creating a fun spot where young teenagers could meet
- creating more community gardens
- better identifying pedestrian crossings in busy intersections.

Project Guidelines

To ensure the safety of city residents, business pilots must comply with the guidelines available at adelaidecitycouncil.com/services/permits-and-licences/activating-adelaide-pilot-projects.html

- applications must include a current copy of Public Liability Insurance for the amount of \$20,000,000
