



Creating a sustainable City through our waste collection

By changing to the three bins for our waste and recycling collections we are reducing what goes to landfill and increasing reuse through recycling.

Yellow Lid (240L)

Items placed in this bin are sorted into groups to be used to produce new products and can be used over and over again

Lime Green Lid (240L)

Items placed in this bin are turned into compost, mulch and soil that is used to grow new organic life to continue the cycle

Red Lid (140L)

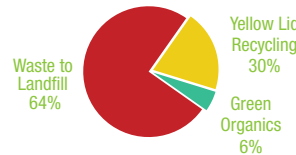
Items placed in this bin go directly to landfill and have no further life cycle

In 2010-11 we have:

Diverted 2,401 tonnes of material from landfill recovered for a new life cycle

- Turned 1,954 tonnes of recycling into products such as cardboard, posts and furniture
- Recovered 447 tonnes of green organics, turning lawn cuttings, pruning and food waste into compost, mulch and soil for putting back into gardens

Not suitable for recycling

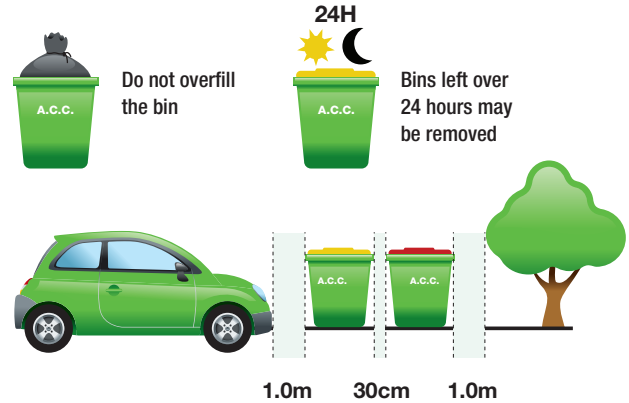


Mirrors, ceramics & window glass
